Job Summary:

Under supervision, manage, as well as coordinate maintenance and operations of, the UC Davis Bee Biology Facility including the physical building, grounds, managed bee populations, Haagen Dazs Honey Bee Haven garden, plant materials for bee forage and nutrition and other related components.

Maintain apiaries and manage UC Davis honey bee colonies for annual almond pollination and honey production. This will include moving hives, constructing and repairing hives, hive equipment, removing frames and extracting honey. Coordinate with research teams to prepare colonies for UC Davis research and extension programs.

Guide and assist undergraduates, graduate student researchers and visitors to The Facility in bee research.

Implement and monitor campus lab safety program. Maintain safety protocols for the bee facility and shop.

Physical Demands:

Lift and carry boxes, honey bee supers and equipment weighing up to 50 lbs.

Work Environment:

Work in the presence of live bees. Cannot be allergic to bees.

Work in a bee suit in summer temperatures in our region.

Valid driver's license to drive a truck with manual transmission.

Work with basic grounds equipment.

Work in field during extreme temperatures.

Work with standard herbicides and pesticides with appropriate training.

Work occasional overtime during heavy field season.
